### Prama Bhardwaj, Founder and CEO of Mantis World

Prama Bhardwaj has lived between Kenya, Tanzania, India and the UK. She studied Development Economics for her Master's degree, with a focus on development in Africa. In 2000, Prama founded Mantis World: an award-winning supplier of sustainably sourced "blank" clothing to the imprintables market, including Mantis, Babybugz, Superstar, One, Mantis Kids & Mantis Mini. The company's heritage came through working with their family-owned fully transparent and certified vertical mill in Tanzania. Over the years the company diversified supply routes to mills in Pakistan, Turkey, India, UK and Bangladesh, operating on the same criteria of sustainability and transparency. Recently Mantis World announced their pledge to have 100% organic or recycled cotton in their range by 2021.

Prama is also a board member of the Ethical Fashion Forum and the Textile Exchange Europe, works on education of the industry, awareness building on fast fashion and women's rights.

## Alex Cheatle, Founder and CEO of Ten Lifestyle Group PLC

Alex set up Ten Lifestyle Group when he was 28 years old in a shared 'post-student' flat with almost no money and a borrowed laptop. The ambitious mission was (and is) to become the most trusted service business in the world!
